COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

AUGUST 3, 2021

REGULAR MEETING

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderswoman of the Town of Port Barre met in regular session in the town hall on Tuesday, August 3, 2021, at the hour of 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Ardoin called the meeting to order. Present were: Pickney, Hardy and Robin. Absent: Barron and Abshire.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderswoman of the Town of Port Barre, Parish of St. Landry, State of Louisiana, were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor John P. Ardoin, whom stated that the Council was ready for the transaction of business.

Motion by Pickney, seconded by Robin, accepting the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on July 6, 2021, and to dispense with the reading thereof. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin gave an update on business items from last month's meeting.

Motion by Pickney, seconded by Hardy granting Mayor Ardoin permission to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with St. Landry Parish Government for use of Parish equipment. Unanimous.

Motion by Robin, seconded by Pickney granting Mayor Ardoin permission to start the process of a Bond Issue for streets. Unanimous.

Motion by Hardy, seconded by Pickney granting permission to rent the back side portion of the Community Center for small events. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Chief Boudreaux. Assistant Chief Hardy was present and rendered the monthly report of activities of the Police Department.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Superintendent Gregory Leger, who gave an update on public works activities and projects.

Motion by Pickney, seconded by Hardy accepting all financial and departmental reports. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon the Town Council, then the audience. General discussion was had, including fire hydrant repairs, street repairs, erosion at the boat launch, garbage trucks, affordable housing, on-line payments and retirement program.

Motion by Pickney, seconded by Robin to adjourn. Unanimous.
