COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

AUGUST 5, 2025

REGULAR MEETING

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Aldерwoman of the Town of Port Barre met in regular session in the town hall on Tuesday, August 5, 2025, at the hour of 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Ardoin called the meeting to order. Present were: Robin, S. Hardy and G. Hardy. Absent: Hebert and Kimble.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Aldерwoman of the Town of Port Barre, Parish of St. Landry, State of Louisiana, were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor John P. Ardoin, whom stated that the Council was ready for the transaction of business.

Motion by Robin, seconded by S. Hardy, accepting the minutes of the Regular Meetings held on July 1, 2025, and to dispense with the reading thereof. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Chief Boudreaux, who rendered the monthly report of Police Department activities.

Mayor Ardoin gave update on Youth League activities advising that Flag Football registration had begun. Alderman Greg Hardy gave a recap of the AllStar playoffs for the 12-U team.
