COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

JULY 1, 2025

REGULAR MEETING

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Aldерwoman of the Town of Port Barre met in regular session in the town hall on Tuesday, July 1, 2025, at the hour of 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Ardoin called the meeting to order. Present were: Robin, Hebert, Kimble and G. Hardy. Absent: S. Hardy.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Aldерwoman of the Town of Port Barre, Parish of St. Landry, State of Louisiana, were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor John P. Ardoin, whom stated that the Council was ready for the transaction of business.

Motion by Robin, seconded by Hebert, accepting the minutes of the Regular Meetings held on June 3, 2025, and to dispense with the reading thereof. Unanimous.

Motion by Robin, seconded by Kimble accepting the resignation of Assistant Chief Robert Hardy. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Chief Boudreaux, who rendered the monthly report of Police Department activities.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Gregory Leger, Town Superintendent, who gave an update on all public works activities.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Kyla Rivette, Parks & Recreation Director, who gave an update on all Youth League and Parks and Recreation activities.


Motion by Hebert, seconded by Robin accepting all financial and departmental reports. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon the Town Council, then the audience. General discussion was had, including the water well project, culverts, purchasing of a jetter machine, the unpaid utility bill at 1104 Saizan Avenue and the responsibility of landlords with regards to same, and also being held accountable for locked meters.
