COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

MARCH 3, 2026

REGULAR MEETING

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderswoman of the Town of Port Barre met in regular session in the town hall on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, at the hour of 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Ardoin called the meeting to order. Present were: Hebert, Robin and Kimble. Absent: S. Hardy and G. Hardy.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderswoman of the Town of Port Barre, Parish of St. Landry, State of Louisiana, were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor John P. Ardoin, whom stated that the Council was ready for the transaction of business.

Motion by Hebert, seconded by Robin, accepting the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on February 3, 2026, and to dispense with the reading thereof. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Chief Boudreaux. Assistant Chief Robert Hardy was in attendance and rendered the monthly report of Police Department activities. He also mentioned that they made contact with DOTD regarding the incorporating of Hwy. 190, East to Bayou Courtableau and West to Hwy. 743.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Superintendent Greg Leger who gave an update on public works activities. He also advised that the water distribution site project was completed and that the replacement of the street signs was still on going.

Mayor Ardoin advised that Parks & Recreation Director Kyla Rivette was not present, but gave an update on Youth League activities, particularly that we are in the process of Weeball, Baseball and Softball registrations. Discussion was also had regarding uniforms and sponsorships.

Motion by Kimble, seconded by Hebert accepting all financial and departmental reports. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon the Council, then the audience. General discussion was had, including the sidewalk project, the Glass Systems building, grass cutting and trash.

Motion by Hebert, seconded by Robin to adjourn. Unanimous.
