A public hearing was held in the Town Hall from 5:30 p.m. to 6:12 p.m. to allow citizens to provide comments and opinions on the proposed budget for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026, and proposed amendments to the budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025. Brad and Burton Kolder presented the proposed 2025-2026 budget and amendments to the 2024-2025 budget. There was discussion had between the Council and the auditors regarding utility consumption rates, depreciation, sewer rates and rate studies.

Mayor Ardoin closed the public hearing at 6:12 p.m. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderwoman of the Town of Port Barre met in special session in the Town Hall on Tuesday, September 23, 2025, at the hour of 6:12 p.m.

Mayor Ardoin called the meeting to order. Present were: Robin, Hebert, Kimble, S. Hardy and G. Hardy. Absent: None.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderwoman of the Town of Port Barre, Parish of St. Landry, State of Louisiana, were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by the Honorable Mayor, John P. Ardoin, whom stated that the Council was ready for the transaction of business.

Motion by Robin, seconded by S. Hardy adopting Ordinance No. 1 of 2025, Amended Budget Ordinance for fiscal year ending September 30, 2025. Unanimous.

Motion by Kimble, seconded by S. Hardy adopting Ordinance No. 2 of 2025, Budget Ordinance for Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 2026. Before going to a vote, Alderman G. Hardy asked to have further discussion regarding the \$1.00 increase in consumption rates for water and sewer. There was additional discussion had among the Mayor, Council and the auditors. Mayor Ardoin called for a vote to adopt and the vote was Robin, Hebert, Kimble and S. Hardy - yea; G. Hardy - nay. Motion carried by majority vote.

Motion by Hebert, seconded by G. Hardy to adjourn. Unanimous.
